Bert and Martha (Pietruszewski) Kuznia

Bert Kuznia, the son of Albert and Hedwig (Krzyzosiak) Kuznia, was born December 2, 1887. He had a twin brother, Michael. Their homeplace was located one mile west and one mile south of Florian, where the Hilary Kuznia family presently live.

Bert met Martha Pietruszewski, the daughter of Martin and Mary (Safranski) Pietruszewski. Martha was born June 30, 1899, in Marshall County, Minnesota. She has six brothers: Frank, John (who married Laura Cybulski), Anton (who married Hedwig Kuznia), Thomas (who married Antonette Kasprowicz), Stanley (who married Frances Wilebski), and Felix (who married Theresa Kasprowicz). She also has four sisters: Mary Kaliszewski, Helen Banaszewski, Polly Stalock, and Elizabeth (Elsie) Donarski. The Pietruszewski homeplace was about two and one half miles northwest of Florian.

On June 11, 1916, Bert and Martha were married at the Assumption Catholic Church in Florian, Minnesota.

To this union, twelve children were born: August, Thomas, Ralph, Theresa, Raymond, Dorothy, Barbara, Leonard, Eleanor, Florence, Antionette, and Robert. Their first home was built by Anton Kuznia for about \$700-\$800, and it was located in Wanger Township, three miles west and one mile north of Florian. In 1926, they rented 320 acres and moved to Augsburg Township, seven miles east of Stephen, Minnesota. Later they bought the farm, which had many buildings. From 1880-1889, the farm had been part of the original holdings of Wheeler and Culbertson. Later, it was well known as the Schoonover farm. It had been purchased by Irwin P. Schoonover in 1912 or 1913.

As the kids took over the farm work, Bert liked to sit out front of the house and pray the rosary as he watched what went on about the yard. Often he must have said many rosaries in a day. They raised the usual farm stock, including chickens, ducks, and geese.

Martha enjoyed Tuesday night bingo in town. While they were still milking cows on the farm, she would bring in a large gallon jug of fresh milk to her son's family in town, and then she would go enjoy playing bingo.

They lived on the farm until they retired in 1959 and had a new home built in north Stephen, Minnesota. It was built by John A. Kuznia. They enjoyed living in Stephen. Bert would make his daily trips uptown walking and would stop and visit his brother, Peter Kuznia, who also lived in Stephen. But it was only for three short years. as Bert became ill and passed away on July 11, 1962, at the age of 75 years at St. Francis Hospital in Crookston, Minnesota. He died from cancer.

Martha continued to make her home at Stephen, but also for

only a short while. She died unexpectedly on April 1, 1964, at South St. Paul Hospital. She had been visiting her sisters and some of her children.

Bert was a member of the Knights of Columbus, and they were both members of St. Stephen's Catholic Church at Stephen. Bert and Martha are buried in St. Stephen's Cemetery.

A son, Raymond Peter, preceded them in death. Raymond Peter was born December 13, 1925, and died August 11, 1927, from pneumonia.

AUGUST AND JOANN [GAJESKI] KUZNIA Stephen, Minnesota 56757

August Kuznia was the first child born to Bert and Martha (Pietruszewski) Kuznia. He was born in 1918 at their home in Wanger Township, Marshall County, Minnesota. He first attended school by what is presently the Joe Kazmierczak farm in Augsburg Township. Later, his parents moved to Augsburg Township, and he attended a school about a mile north of John Jensen's place. August said he walked to school and didn't drive like the kids do today.

In 1944, at a house party at the Roman Gajeski home, he met his future wife, Joann Gajeski. On June 16, 1945, they were married. Joann is the daughter of Walter and Rose (Perkerewicz) Gajeski. Her parents are of Polish descent.

For the first year of their married life, they lived upstairs over the Gamble Store in Stephen, Minnesota. In 1946, they moved to a farmstead in Fork Township, section 13.

They are the parents of eight children: Alvina, Rita, Duane, Mona Rae, David, Gary, Grace, and Diane. They have twelve grandchildren.

When he was about eight years old, his parents moved to Augsburg Township, seven miles east of Stephen, Minnesota. He then attended District 55 school, about two miles north of their home.

Between 1930 and 1942, he helped his father with farming, and he worked part time for neighbors, hand picking potatoes (at 3 or 4 cents a bushel) and hauling grain bundles with a threshing crew. He also remembers hauling grain to Stephen with a team of horses. The treat on the way home would often be crackers and a ham sandwich. There were a few times when the team of horses ran home ahead of their driver!!

Later on, about 1928, his father bought a 10-20 McCormick International tractor. This made field work much easier. Tom and his brother, August, helped with the plowing. August drove, and Thomas would pull the rope to lift the plow out of the ground. It took both of them, as they were only about eight or nine years old.

In 1942, Thomas entered service with the 85th Infantry Division. His basic training was at Camp Shelby, Mississippi, Camp Polk, Louisiana, and a couple other camps in the States. In November of 1966, he entered the United State Army, serving an eighteen-month tour in Germany. After the service, Gerald was employed in construction until 1972.



Kenneth graduated from the Northwest School in Crookston, Minnesota, in 1938. He helped his dad in farming until 1941, then he moved to California and went to work for the Consolidated Aircraft Company in San Diego, building B-24 bombers.






