Thomas and Anna (Kuznia) Wilebski

Anna Kuznia was born September 13, 1890, in Section 7 of Wright Township in Marshall County, Minnesota, to Albert and Hedwig (Krzyzosiak) Kuznia. She spent her whole childhood in the Florian community. She met her husband-to-be, Thomas Wilebski, when he came to Florian, Minnesota, for a church doing. His sister, Mary, had married Anna's brother, Anton, in the very early 1900's.

On July 12, 1910, at the Assumption Catholic Church in Florian, Minnesota, Anna married Thomas Wilebski. They rode in the first car in Stephen, Minnesota, a Mordiek car -- a 1910 no top touring car -- to the church for their wedding. The wedding celebration at the Albert Kuznia homeplace lasted twenty-four hours.

Tom was the son of Frank and Antonette (Januczek) Wilebski from Orleans, Minnesota. Thomas was born on December 19, 1884, at Ivanhoe, Minnesota.

Following is a list of birth and death dates for Tom's parents, brothers, and sisters:

Frank Wilebski (father) was born November 15, 1854 and died July 4, 1928. Antonette (Januczek) Wilebski (mother) was born January 17, 1860 and died January 29, 1914. Joseph Wilebski was born February 19, 1882 and died in July of 1958. Mary Ann Wilebski (Kuznia) was born September 6, 1883 and died December 27, 1903. Frances Wilebski (Olsonoski) was born November 7, 1886 and died December 14, 1918. Sam Wilebski was born August 2, 1888 and died October 25, 1945. Peter Wilebski was born June 27, 1890 and

died October 10, 1961. John Wilebski was born January 17, 1892, and died October 7, 1973. Anna Wilebski (Clark) was born June 11, 1893 and died January 12, 1964. Antonette Wilebski (Price) was born December 27, 1894 and died July 2, 1960. Stanley Wilebski was born April 28, 1897 and died April 23, 1958. Victoria Wilebski (Loby) was born October 27, 1898 and died September 28, 1965. Stella Wilebski (Kollinger) was born February 28, 1903 and died February 3, 1941.

After Anna and Tom were married, they moved to Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada, where their first child, Helen, was born. While there, Tom sold beer from a wagon. Shortly after that, they moved to Kroze, Minnesota, where Frances was born. From there, they moved to Florian, Minnesota, and occupied a house where the Florian Community Hall now stands. Later, the house was moved to the Ben Kuznia farm, not quite a mile west of Florian. Some years later, it burned. In Florian, Tom was a blacksmith.

The Wilebski family then moved to a farm by Argyle, Minnesota. By Argyle, the family farmed and Tom did carpenter work, building barns and granaries. The farm home was later moved to the town of Argyle.

In 1940, they moved to 900 5th Avenue South, South St. Paul, Minnesota. Tom was a car repairman for the Rock Island Railroad for twelve years before retiring.

Tom passed away from cancer on November 14, 1964. As of

February of 1980, Anna is still a very sick woman. She became ill in July of 1978, and now her health is rapidly failing.

DONALD AND DOROTHY [PLISEK] STALOCK 1825 North Clarence Street St. Paul, Minnesota




